Qualifications

- All applicants must have successfully completed the Youth Entrepreneurs class during high school and be in good standing with Youth Entrepreneurs. Current students may apply but any award depends on their successful completion of the class.
- Applicants will only be considered for award between their junior year of high school and their 23rd birthday
- Applicants should apply for all scholarships for which they are eligible.
- Only one scholarship may be awarded to an applicant in an academic year.
- If you have been awarded a scholarship in a previous year, you may apply again this year. Scholarship awards are restricted to two (2) during a lifetime.

Please indicate all scholarships for which you are applying at the bottom of this page. Note: that by selecting a scholarship you are agreeing to meet the eligibility standards; failure to meet these standards may result in loss of scholarship.

Only one completed set of forms needs to be submitted regardless of the number of scholarships checked.

All scholarships will be available to the recipient the next academic year and must be redeemed within 5 calendar years of the award date.

REQUIREMENTS FOR ELIGIBILITY

- 6 hours of YE Academy sessions prior to disbursement of 1st installment (commencement of 1st year)
- 3 hours of YE Academy sessions prior to disbursement of 3rd installment (commencement of 2nd year)
- Submit a copy of official transcript at the end of each term (for determination of disbursement of next term's payment)
- Maintain a 3.25 Cumulative post-secondary GPA
- Maintain full time status
- Complete exit survey prior to final installment

NOTE: Individuals awarded the Joint Venture Scholarship will NOT be eligible for future YE scholarships.
