**DODGE CITY COMMUNITY COLLEGE  
YE SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES  
2012-2013 ACADEMIC YEAR**

**Dodge City Community College (DCCC) agrees to provide 5 YE Scholarships\* in the amount of tuition, incidental fees & loan of books to Youth Entrepreneurs (YE) to be awarded to eligible students as determined by the YE organization. The following terms and conditions apply:**

1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually to a student(s) enrolled full time at DCCC during the 2012-2013 academic year.
2. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a veteran or disability.
3. Recipient(s) must be graduates of the YE program. YE graduates are eligible up to 22 years of age.
4. Scholarships will include payment of tuition and incidental fees and loan of textbooks (workbooks and expendable books not included).
5. Recipient(s) must maintain a 3.7 cumulative GPA on a 4.0 scale at DCCC to renew the scholarship after each semester.
6. Scholarships are contingent upon available funds from DCCC. YE will contact DCCC annually to verify availability of funds.
7. Recipient recommendation(s) will be submitted by YE in writing before March 31 and should include all relevant student contact information.
8. The scholarship office at DCCC will administer the scholarship(s) and make the award(s) based on recommendations submitted by YE.
9. The scholarship(s) could be renewed for a second year as long as students achieve a grade point average of at least 3.7 on a 4.0 scale as defined by DCCC.

\*YE Scholarships will be provided to those who qualify by meeting the requirements of YE and Dodge City Community College.
