NAMED SCHOLARSHIP GUIDELINES  
2012-2013 ACADEMIC YEAR**

**Garden City Community College (GCCC) agrees to provide 4 scholarships in the amount of \$500 to Youth Entrepreneurs (YE) to be awarded to an eligible student(s) as determined by the YE organization. The following terms and conditions apply:**

1. Scholarship(s) will be awarded annually to a student(s) enrolled full time at GCCC during the 2012-2013 academic year.
2. Scholarship(s) is valid for the 2012-2013 academic year and will be split equally between the fall and spring semesters.
3. No recipient will be excluded from consideration based on race, religion, color, national origin, gender, sexual orientation, marital status, status as a veteran or disability.
4. Recipients must be graduates of the YE program. YE graduates are eligible up to 22 years of age.
5. Scholarships are contingent upon available funds from GCCC. YE will contact GCCC annually to verify availability of funds.
6. Recipient recommendation(s) will be submitted by YE in writing before March 31 and should include all relevant student contact information.
7. The Financial Aid office at GCCC will administer the scholarship and make the award based on recommendations submitted by YE. Scholarship will be applied to student account and has no cash value.
8. Recipients will receive an official award notification letter from GCCC. Students should contact Ryan Ruda, Dean of Student Services to redeem scholarship(s).
9. The scholarship(s) will not be automatically renewed, but students are welcome to reapply according to YE scholarship guidelines.
